desperation – something done from hopelessness and worry

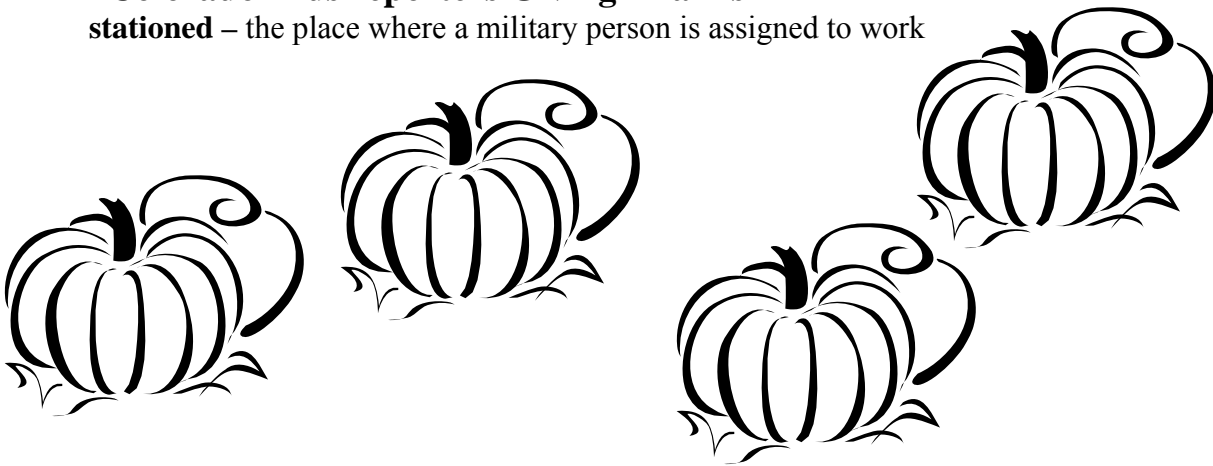
potent – powerful
