**Tampa Bay, FLORIDA** – The Tampa Bay Rays pulled off one of the biggest turn-arounds in the history of professional sports.

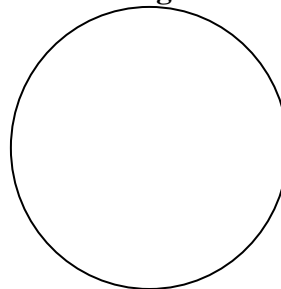
