## Baby elephant

**pachyderm** -- large, thick-skinned animal such as an elephant, rhinoceros or hippopotamus

**trust** -- a group or account set up to use money for a particular purpose, such as a charity or for the benefit of children not old enough to handle their own money.

## Tiny fossils

**bacterium** -- a single bacteria

**diplodocus** -- a large, herbivorous dinosaur of the late Jurassic period

## Miller Farms

**generations** -- groups of people born at roughly the same time, or a group of family members such as brothers, sisters and cousins who make up the same step in the family history.

**festival** -- a time of celebration with a specific theme

## “Ranger’s Apprentice”

**epic** -- a long story telling of a hero, often also telling about a nation or people through his adventures

**medieval** -- having to do with the Middle Ages, a historic period from about 600 to 1500 AD

**fief** -- an estate given to a nobleman by his king or emperor in return for political and military support

## Libya

**transition** -- A period of change from one situation to another

**funds** -- money and things such as stocks and bonds that can quickly be turned into money

## Senator Bennet

**compromise** -- when two groups agree to a deal even though each had to give up some of what they wanted
